SHOW RULES

All persons entering the Showground must have Personal & Public Liability Insurance.

The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property while on the Showground. Please note that under NO circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and Grooms enter the Showrings.

The decision of the judge is final. Any objections must be made in writing within one hour of the class/incident finishing and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £25.00.

The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.

All trophies must be signed for in the Secretary's Office; they will be held for just one year and must be returned to the Branch upon request.

Mountain and Moorland ponies must be shown in accordance with their Breed Society Rules.

No entry fees are returnable unless a vet's certificate is produced, a £5 Admin fee will be incurred.

All ridden Show Pony classes are held according to the rules laid down in the current B.S.P.S. Handbook.

In-foal mares may be asked to produce a certificate of service.

Prize money may be collected from the Secretary's tent on the day of the Show only, money not collected on the day will be deemed as a donation to Derbyshire Branch. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize money will be awarded in each class, provided there are a minimum of 6 entries: if less 1st prize only will be awarded.

Numbers will be sent if entries are accompanied by an s.a.e.; otherwise collect on the day.

Stallions may not be lead or ridden by children under 12 years of age (small breeds) and 14 years of age all others to qualify for PUK Championships.

This Show operates under the the NCPA Child & Vulnerable Adults Protection Policy.

The BSPS Premier League Competition – the qualification will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies in the following classes: Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Ponies; Lead rein Show Hunter Type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Show Hunter Ponies; 153cms and 158cms, Intermediate Show Riding Type, Intermediate Show Hunter and Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and Open Heritage Ridden. The Final to be at the BSPS Summer Championships 2010.

All persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes whether or not a member of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a Qualifier for the P(UK) 2011 Winter Championships. Qualification is open to P(UK) Members and Non-Members. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class will qualify. Competitors in qualifying positions who are not current members of PUK are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. Qualification Cards will not be presented in the ring.

This Show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show in 2011. 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners in the appropriate classes will qualify and the highest placed not already qualified in the first six for the Part Bred Welsh Championships.

The BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge 2011. All shows that are affiliated to the BSPS are qualifiers for the Challenge. Lead rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Open Intermediate, SRT, Show Hunters. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2010 the Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the "Challenge", the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

If after qualifying a pony qualifies for either of the above it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.
